He graduated Tokyo University, College of Arts and Science in 1963. He got Ph.D in Political Science from Waseda University. He Joined The Institute of Energy Economics, Japan in 1966. Chief Economist of The Institute of Energy Economics, Japan. In 1994, he became Professor of Ryukoku University, Faculty of Intercultural Communication. He retired Ryukoku University in 2007 and came back to the IEEJ as Councilor.

He was a visiting researcher at the German Institute of Economics in 1969-1970 and a member of the Long Term Energy Assessment Unit, OECD in 1973. He has been a consultant for the ESCAP in 1978-79 and a staff of the UN Conference on New and Renewable Sources of Energy in 1981-82. He has been Chair of the APEC Expert Group on Energy Data Analysis from 1991. He was President of the International Association for Energy Economics in 1995 and received Outstanding Contribution to the IAEE Award in 2009. He published several books on energy including "Energy Questions !" (NTT Publishing Co. 2010.
