Larry Chow is currently Professor in the Department of Geography at Hong Kong Baptist University and Director of the Hong Kong Energy Studies Centre. In addition to having written a number of articles for professional journals such as Energy Policy, OPEC Review, China Quarterly, and Economic Bulletin for Asia and Pacific, Prof. Chow also serves on the international editorial board of Energy Policy and Energy Sources Part B. He was the guest editor of four special issues of Energy Policy, focusing on the themes “Themes in Current Asian Energy,” “Power Market Reform in Selected Asian Countries,” “Thirty Years of World Energy Policy” and “Greater China Energy.” He also co-edited a special issue of Energy – The International Journal (with C.K. Woo) dealing with power market restructuring.

In the recent past, he served on three government advisory boards in Hong Kong, one of which was the Energy Advisory Committee.
