## Conclusion of Collaboration Agreement with Qatar General Electricity and Water Corporation For Cooperation on Energy Efficiency in the State of Qatar

The Institute of Energy Economics, Japan (IEEJ) has just concluded with Qatar General Electricity and Water Corporation (KAHRAMAA) the Collaboration Agreement For Cooperation on Energy Efficiency in the State of Qatar.

KAHRAMAA is in charge of promoting a national energy conservation program called TARSHEED, and the realization of its energy conservation targets is one of the important policy goals for achieving the Qatar National Vision (QNV2030).

The cooperation will be implemented with the support of the Qatar government and the Japanese government (the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry). Specifically, it aims to help achieve TARSHEED's energy conservation targets in the short term and help strengthen energy efficiency policies in Qatar in the long term, by the end of March 2024.
