Dr. Jung will present the findings of, “APEC Energy Demand and Supply Outlook 2002” published in September. He will also touch upon climate change issues and China’s motorization as they relate to APEC’s energy demand and supply situation. The presentation will be in English without translation.

Dr. Yonghun Jung, a Korean national, is currently serving as the vice president of the APEC Energy Research Centre in Tokyo Japan. He had received a doctoral degree in Economics from the University of Rochester. Before he was seconded to APERC, he was a senior fellow at the Korea Energy Economics Institute and a visiting scholar at the Australian National University.

Dr. Jung was actively involved in both Climate change and Pipeline natural gas projects. He served the Korean government as an advisor on Climate Change Negotiation until the end of 1998, managing the publication of the Korea’s First National Communication to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change. He published a number of articles in this area as well.

The Asia Pacific Energy Research Centre (APERC) was established in July 1996 in Tokyo, as an affiliated body to the Institute of Energy Economics, Japan (IEEJ), following the Action Agenda adopted by the APEC Economic Leaders at the Osaka Meeting in November 1995. The President of APERC as of October 2002 is Mr. Masaharu Fujitomi.
